

NOTICE TO THE MARKET

Itaúsa and its controlling shareholders to donate R\$ 100 million to fight coronavirus effects in Brazil

ITAÚSA – Investimentos Itaú S.A. (“Itaúsa” or “Company”) announces to its shareholders and the market in general that the Company's Board of Directors, in order to support public health activities and contribute to the fight of coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19), has approved the donation of R\$ 50 million to the “**Todos pela Saúde**” (*All for Health*) alliance. In addition, the controlling shareholders of Itaúsa, members of the Setubal and Villela Families, will also donate R\$ 50 million to the same alliance.

“**Todos pela Saúde**”, created in April with the donation of R\$ 1 billion made by Itaú Unibanco Holding S.A., an invested company of Itaúsa, operates through four axes of action: (i) Informing (guiding the population and equipment usage training), (ii) Protecting (purchase of protective and preventive equipment, such as face masks, and use of remote medicine), (iii) Caring (purchase of tests and hospital equipment, construction of temporary hospitals and new ICU beds) and (iv) Resuming (investment in preparing society to resumption of social activities). The project's resources are managed by a group of experts from different healthcare sectors. More details are available on the website <https://www.todospelasaude.org/> (Portuguese only).

The Company's Management and its controlling shareholders, aware of their role in society and in line with their corporate and social values, believe that these donations reinforce their commitment to people and to Brazil at this moment that calls for action and solidarity, and express their desire to be able to contribute, on behalf of its almost 700 thousand shareholders, to the control of the pandemic and reduction of its impacts on society.
