Built in 1963, San Joaquín is the biggest campus of PUC. It is the home of 13 faculties and more than 20,000 students. The PUC School of Engineering is located here since the 60's.

The visit will begin with a tour in the Science and Technology Building: a space dedicated to training world - class students during their first years of higher education, in order to foster the development of scientific and technological skills.

The visit will continue with a seismic test in the labs of the Department of Structural and Geotechnical Engineering.

We will then visit the PUC Innovation Center, which since 2014 seeks to foster and promote a culture and environment of innovation, promoting joint projects between the university, the public sector and industry.
